The performance of the school over these years has been outstanding in all areas.

RESULTS OF THE SSE AND SSCE 2024

It is with immense pleasure that I begin the Annual Report with the 2023 Board exam results.

In the SSE (X), out of 145 students there were 90 distinctions, 42 first classes and 9 second classes. Pavithra SL secured the first place with **98%**, Devapriya DS secured the second place with 97% and Varsha P Siju the third place with 96.6%. Varsha P Siju, Sara Shamnad, Bhavya Krishna MS and Neeraj Baiju secured **100/100** in Maths. Devapriya DS, Varsha P Siju, Pavithra SL, Geethu S. Anil, Bhavya Krishna MS, Abhigna Ajay, Aiswarya Prasad and Anagha Maria Antony secured **100/100** in Malayalam.

In the SSCE(XII), out of 98 students there were 64 distinctions and 33 first classes. Akhil S secured the first place with **95.4%**, Abhinand S and R Nandhitha secured the second place with 95.2% and Parvathy Jayakrishnan secured the third place with 95%.

Abhinand S secured **100/100** in Physics and Chemistry and Akhil S secured **100/100** in Computer Science.
